Hazing Policy

General:

Hazing refers to any activity expected of someone joining a group that humiliates, degrades or risks emotional and/or physical harm regardless of the person's willingness to participate.

Policy:

Mary of Lourdes School will not tolerate hazing of any student by other students. All students are to be treated with dignity and respect.

Any students found to be involved with hazing shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary action from a warning, detention, suspension and expulsion.

Reporting:

Any student, who feels he or she is a victim of hazing, should immediately report the incident to the building principal. Every report of an incident is confidential and will be thoroughly investigated.
