### **MOL REGISTRATION REMINDER**

Our 2018-19 MOL registration packets were sent home (with youngest in the family) last week for all current families in Grades K-8. We will use a two-week window for current families to return registration forms to school. Families who complete their registrations by Friday, March 9<sup>th</sup> will be entered into a SCRIP DRAWING, as well as RECEIVE 2 VOLUNTEER CREDITS that will go towards your family's volunteerism involvement for next school year. We encourage families to register as soon as possible. After March 9<sup>th</sup>, the school will accept registrations from the greater public. *THANKS for your help turning in your registrations early!*

### **FAIR APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE**

Each year MOL School sets aside scholarship funds for families who could benefit from some tuition assistance. The school asks that all families interested in a tuition scholarship, please call either school office as soon as possible to request a FAIR tuition application OR you may complete it online. If interested in receiving the online information and directions, please go to the FAIR website ([www.fairapp.com](http://www.fairapp.com)) and punch in the school code "146" and the school password "mols146". In order for families to apply online, please have the following items ready: \* The MOL School Code & Password \* A valid e-mail address \* A credit card to complete payment processing (Visa or Mastercard) \* A complete copy of your 2017 Federal Income Tax Return with all schedules and W-2's. **All applications are due to the FAIR office by the April**

**15<sup>th</sup>**. A \$30.00 processing fee is required by FAIR. All applicant information is kept confidential. Families who apply for a scholarship will be sent tuition reward information by late May, after the applications have all been processed. For those families who apply and do not qualify for a scholarship, they may contact either building principal to apply for a "Support a Student" scholarship (another scholarship program that is offered at MOLS) or contact their parish priest for tuition support.
