MOL REGISTRATION REMINDER

Our 2018-19 MOL registration packets were sent home (with youngest in the family) a few weeks ago for all current families in Grades K–8. We encourage families to register as soon as possible. The current family registration fee is \$25.00. The registration fee increases to \$75.00 on April 3rd. *THANKS for your help turning in your registrations early!*

*PLEASE NOTE: There was a typo mistake on the 2018-2019 MOL Catholic Registration Form. The Catholic family tuition is \$2,375 per student. An updated registration form was attached to the Feb. 23rd newsletter, if you would like to complete that form (instead of the one in your packets). Thank you!

FAIR APPLICATIONS AVAILABLE

Each year MOL School sets aside scholarship funds for families who could benefit from some tuition assistance. The school asks that all families interested in a tuition scholarship, please call either school office as soon as possible to request a FAIR tuition application OR you may complete it online. If interested in receiving the online information and directions, please go to the FAIR website (www.fairapp.com) and punch in the school code "146"

and the school password "mols146". In order for families to apply online, please have the following items ready:

* The MOL School Code & Password * A valid e-mail address * A credit card to complete payment processing (Visa or Mastercard) * A complete copy of your 2017 Federal Income Tax Return with all schedules and W-2's.

All applications are due to the FAIR office by the April 15th. A \$30.00 processing fee is required by FAIR. All applicant information is kept confidential. Families who apply for a scholarship will be sent tuition reward information by late May, after the applications have all been processed. For those families who apply and do not qualify for a scholarship, they may contact either building principal to apply for a "Support a Student" scholarship (another scholarship program that is offered at MOLS) or contact their parish priest for tuition support.

LENTEN RICE BOWL REMINDER

MOL elementary and middle school students received "Rice Bowls" at the beginning of Lent as part of our school's annual Lenten Project. We are asking our students to place collected coins in their bowls. The donations will go to Catholic Relief Services to aid those most in need. The elementary rice bowls will be collected on Thursday, March 29th at 10:00 when we gather to pray and sing the Chaplet. The middle school rice bowls will be gathered on Holy Thursday, as well.
